COVID-19 additional information – Thursday 9 December

In light of the Government announcement yesterday that Plan B is to begin this Friday, we wanted to make clear that the health and safety of you, as our guests, along with our performers is of paramount importance to us. We will be taking all necessary measures to deliver a COVID-19 safe and secure performance. The Crouch End Players will be following the government's guidance, along with additional measures.

We respectfully request that all guests follow the example of our performers and crew to allow everyone to enjoy the performance and to remain as safe as possible.

Follow the example of cast and crew

- All guests and performers will be asked to consider before attending the event whether they have any COVID-19 symptoms, or whether they have had contact with anyone with symptoms over the past seven days.
- All of our guests and performers are strongly encouraged to carry out a lateral flow test prior to attending the performance, attending only when you have reported a negative result.
- Guests and front of house staff will be requested to wear a face covering (unless exempt) while indoors and not eating or drinking.
- Guests are asked politely to respect 1m social distancing where possible.
- Signage in the toilets will remind all guests to wash hands frequently and for a minimum of 20 seconds.
- Guests and performers will be requested to scan the NHS Track and Trace QR code located on the reception area doors. Should you not have the NHS COVID App you will be asked to record your name and contact details on the performance sheet.
